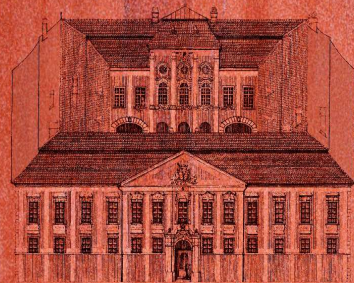




SCHLOSS GOBELSBURG

ZWEIGELT

ORIGIN: The 'classic' ZWEIGELT of Domaene Gobelsburg is a representative of the Danube region, which is – in context to red wine – among the “cool climate” regions. Over the last several decades, this grape variety has developed a strong identity in Austria and especially in the Danube area where this varietal develops wines of great elegance; being a logical choice in our line of red varietals of Burgundian heritage and their successors.

CHARACTER: Our ZWEIGELT exudes a shiny ruby red colour with purple highlights. The nose finds fruitiness with hints of cherries along with spicy nuances. This medium-bodied wine reveals good concentration and juiciness, as well as an elegant, refreshing and mineral acidity that leads to an intense and spicy finish, which make this wine a popular food companion.

WINELIST-DESCRIPTION: ZWEIGELT is the signature red grape of Austria. In the Austrian Danube wine region it develops a „cool climate” style with rounded fruitiness, lively spicy notes and a minerally structured finish.

All the vineyards are located on slopes and terraces around the valley of the river Kamp near the town of Langenlois and the village of Gobelsburg. Schloss Gobelsburg specialises in Grüner Veltliner and Riesling and produces authentic and noble wines from different single vineyard, village and regional appellations. The winery is member of the association 'Österreichische Traditionsweingüter', which is working on a vineyard classification project for the Danube area.
